Aim of the subject and short description

The purpose of the seminar is to support the student in the process of compiling the final paper. Over the final paper's seminars, the main problems of one's paper are discussed with the lecturers, as the experts of their fields, and also with the other the students receive advice to continue with the topic and/or to further research. Over the seminar, the papers planned, are analyzed, compared to papers defended earlier. There will be discussions about literary sources, performance methods, work planning, execution and presentation ways and making conclusions of them. The purpose of the study is to enable the student also to acquire the skill to analyze scientific sources and to use them as a source when compiling their own personal scientific paper. The topics discussed: the types of scientific texts, the structure of a scientific paper, scientific language, the reliability of a source, etc. The mediation of a source: quoting and references, paraphrasing, synthesis, generalization of the materials read. Oral presentations which smooth the performance and debating skills of the post-graduate. The final paper's seminar supports the student in compiling the final paper.
