Aim of the subject and short description

To create the assumptions for acquiring Estonian at a level that allows the student to deal with simple language situations. After completing the course, the student understands and uses everyday expressions and simple phrases to satisfy his or her needs, is able to introduce him- or herself and others. Ask simple questions about the place of residence, familiar persons and things, and can also answer to the same questions, can communicate in a simple language if the interlocutor speaks slowly and clearly and is ready to help.

Learning outcomes:

Student:

- 1. Understands sentences and frequently used phrases that he/she associates with areas important to him/her
- 2. Copes in daily communication situations that require the direct and simple exchange of information on familiar and routine topics.
- 3. Is able to describe his/her family, other people and living conditions with simple phrases and sentences and express his/her needs.
